All-Community Endeavors

Winter Light Faire (Saturday, December 5, 11:00-4:00)

Planning begins early in September for this event. Classrooms, campus, and Great Hall are transformed to reflect the spirit of the season! Includes craft activities, food, entertainment, and merriment. Tasks include setting up and taking down, organization of activities and entertainment, helping with class activities, baking, and decorating.

Spring Benefit Auction (Saturday, March 13, 6-10 pm)

This event is a major fundraiser for the school. Planning meetings begin in October and are facilitated by a committee of volunteers. Our adult community attends the auction and participates in the bidding. This event is held off-campus.

Annual Raffle

Held in conjunction with the Spring Benefit Auction, the raffle is most effective when held by a small, enthusiastic group of volunteers. The whole community participates by selling raffle tickets to win three highly desired prizes, including a trip to Hawaii! Prizes for the most tickets sold, too.

May Faire (Saturday, May 1, 11:00-4:00)

This all-community festival is held the first weekend of May to celebrate the return of Lady Spring! Planning begins in February for entertainment, craft booth activities, Maypole dancing, baking, food booths, plant sales, and games for all ages. Tasks include setting up and taking down, organization of activities and entertainment, helping with class activities, baking, and decorations.

Community Outreach

Volunteers help in many areas reaching out to the county-wide community: planning and organizing for the Eugene Celebration booth and parade float in September, the Alternative Education Fair (sponsored by our school and held at the Eugene Public Library in February), Windows on Waldorf classroom tours, or other events and public relations opportunities.
